HAGATNA, GUAM – The Guam Chamber of Commerce and Port Authority of Guam announced that the **2007 Port of Guam Development Conference** will be held on **September 13-14, 2007** at the **Hilton Guam Resort & Spa**. The purpose of the conference is to come together as a community to supplement the Port master planning process by stimulating constructive discussion on relevant planning issues facing the Port of Guam.

The Port's Master Plan Consultant Team, PB International, Inc. will participate in the discussions to gain first-hand community input to the infrastructure needs of the port in preparation not only for the planned U.S. military build up, but for the anticipated growth of the island economy.
