FACT SHEET

I. WHAT IS THE AWARD?

The GYP of the Year Award is presented to a GYP member who has exemplified commitment to leadership and career advancement, networking, involvement in legislative and economic issues, and dedication to service to our community. The award is named in the honor of the late Reina A. Leddy, President of the Guam Chamber of Commerce (2007 -2009), whose vision inspired the establishment of the Guam Young Professionals.

II. ELIGIBILITY & CRITERIA

- Nominee must be a GYP member (21 to 40 Years of Age);
- An individual nominated by an employer or person known to them. An official nomination form must also be completed and submitted to the Guam Chamber of Commerce by Wednesday, January 3, 2018; and,
- Nominee must be in good standing with the GYP and the Guam Chamber of Commerce and cannot hold an official position with the Executive Committee of the Guam Young Professionals. The GYP Executive Committee includes the following officers: Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary, Treasurer and Sub-Committee Chair(s).

III. SELECTION COMMITTEE

A selection committee made up of members of the Guam Chamber of Commerce will review all nominations and make a final selection.

IV. AWARD CEREMONY

This special award will be recognized and presented at the Guam Young Professionals Annual Event of the Year on Friday, January 26, 2018, at the Sheraton Laguna Guam Resort. An additional highlight of the event includes the recognition of retiring GYP Members who have reached the over 40 benchmark.
