Attached are the bank account details of Philippine government agencies ready to accept monetary donations. These donations may be coursed through the following banks and remittance centers:

- Allied Bank, Marine Drive, Tamuning
- Metrobank, Marine Drive Tamuning
- Philippine National Bank, Micronesia Mall, Dededo
- Shoemart Remittance Center, Agana Shopping Center.

Please note that these institutions have agreed to waive their transaction fees for the transfer of funds, to the named government aid agencies.

With regard to in-kind donations, these may be dropped off at the National Office Supply building in Barrigada and at the Seaside Fish Mart in Manhattan Building, Route 16, Harmon.

Acceptable in-kind donations are non perishable food items, i.e. e canned goods with at least a shelf life of four (4) months from the time of arrival in the Philippines and preferably in flip-top containers, over-the-counter (OTC) medicines, blankets and towels.

The Guam Chamber of Commerce might also wish to support the performances of Mr. Billy Crawford on Sunday, October 4, at 1-3 p.m. in the Agaña Shopping Center and at 4-6 p.m. in the Micronesia Mall, as well as of the Guam Territorial Band, Magis, Cantate and the SBCS honor choir, who are jointly staging a benefit concert on Saturday, 10 October 2009 at 7 p.m. at the Santa Barbara Catholic School, the proceeds of which will benefit Typhoon Ondoy victims.
